- Trees must be picked up by the applicant from nurseries in Walcha or Inverell. Nurseries offer delivery and postage services but this will need to be arranged by the applicant at their cost.
- Those that have already submitted an Expression of Interest (EOI) this year for grant funding do not need to apply for the tree giveaway. You will be considered for the tree giveaway as part of your original EOI.
- Winter is the best time to plant trees in North West NSW. This means the trees will be available for pick up in winter 2016 (date to be advised).
