North West Local Land Services 2015 Feral Pig Control Program

Aerial Feral Pig control

The North West Local Land Services has been successful in obtaining funding through the Commonwealth Government drought support package for the control of pest animals, targeting feral pigs.

The objective of the feral pig control program is to assist farmers participating in existing group coordinated feral pig control programs in drought affected areas.

The North West Local Land Services will allocate funding for aerial feral pig control, by an Expression of Interest process.

All funding will be allocated through a competitive and merit based assessment of applications. The Commonwealth Drought funding is only secured for the 2015 program. The Expression of Interest for aerial pig control programs is available to all North West LLS landholders who have shown a commitment to group coordinated feral pig control.

It is imperative that any group applying for funding show a present and future commitment to sustained feral pig control programs.

1080 Grain Poisoning

As part of the program landholders are able to have grain poisoned with 1080 for the purpose of feral pig control until June 30 2015.

1080/Pindone Accredited Training

North West Local Land Services will be conducting Vertebrate Pest Induction training to provide accreditation for Landholders to use 1080 and Pindone.

This accreditation is valid for 5 years and training will be provided free of charge.
