



2015 FERAL PIG CONTROL PROGRAM

The North West Local Land Services was successful in obtaining funding through the Commonwealth Drought package for the control of pest animals targeting feral pigs. The objective of the feral pig control program is to assist farmers participating in existing group coordinated feral pig control programs in drought affected areas.

The North West Local Land Services will allocate the funding for aerial feral pig control, by an Expression of Interest process. Therefore all funding will be allocated through a competitive and merit based assessment of applications. The Commonwealth Drought funding is only secured for the 2015 program.

The Expression of Interest for aerial pig control programs is available to all North West LLS landholders who have shown a commitment to group coordinated feral pig control. It is imperative that any group applying for funding show a present and future commitment to sustained feral pig control programs.
